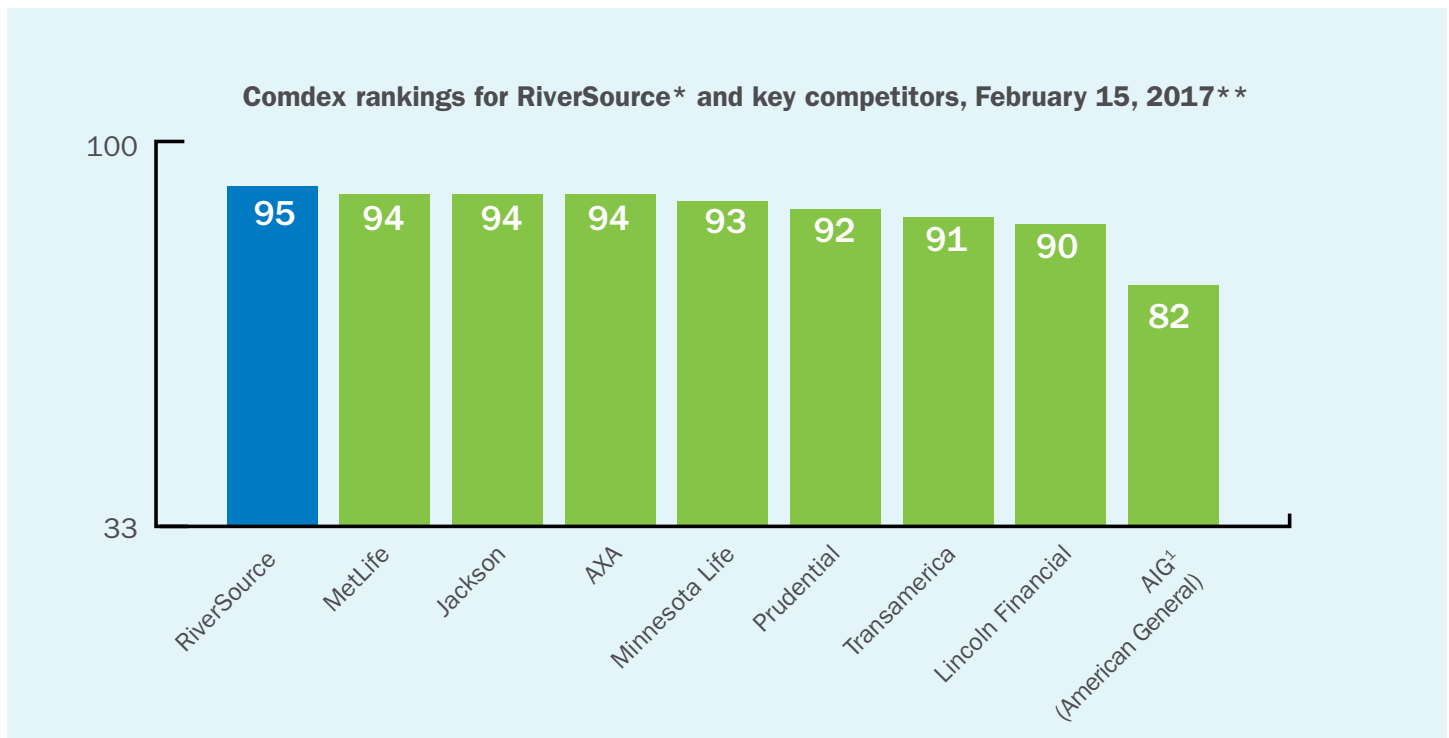

The Comdex ranking is an average percentile of a company's ratings from independent rating agencies. Comdex looks at companies that are rated by at least two rating agencies, then ranks more than 200 of those companies on a scale from 100 (highest) to 1 (lowest), based on their agency ratings.

About Comdex ranking

Rating agencies use different systems, so an A+ rating from one service may not mean the same as an A+ rating from another. Comdex seeks to eliminate these differences and make it easier to compare companies.

Comdex rankings are calculated based on ratings issued by A.M. Best, Standard & Poor's, Moody's Investor Service, and Fitch to score companies on a scale from 100 (highest) to 1 (lowest). A company only needs to be rated by any two rating agencies to receive a Comdex ranking. Comdex rankings are assigned to individual companies rather than company groups.

A company's Comdex ranking can go up or down based on changes in its own ratings, or in the ratings of other companies. Movements in a company's Comdex ranking may not necessarily reflect a ratings upgrade or downgrade.

Comdex rankings are not ratings, and the firm issuing Comdex rankings, EbixExchange, is not a rating agency.
